Report 2020-21 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Maharaja Agrasen College has been constantly working to develop a quality system to improve the academic and administrative performance of the College. The mandate of MAC- IQAC is to develop an all-inclusive quality culture in the college by channeling and synergizing the efforts of all constituent stake holders of the college and work towards academic excellence and progress. The MAC- IQAC 2020-21 comprising of Principal as Chairperson and Dr Maneesha as the Coordinator along with teachers-in-charge and administrative officials work in tandem to prepare the academic calendar prior to the commencement of the session. IQAC organized a National Webinar lecture series for the teaching faculty, non teaching staff and students of Maharaja Agrasen College from 2 -4 June 2020. On 2 June 2020, Dr S B Rathore, Former Associate Professor, Commerce Department, Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi enlightened the teaching faculty and the non teaching staff on the topic 'An Analysis of Opting Old Tax Rates Regime for Financial Year 2020-21'. On 3 June 2020, Prof. Ramesh C. Gaur, Dean & Director (Library & Information) & Head-Kala Nidhi Division at Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), Ministry of Culture, Government of India addressed the teaching faculty and research scholars on the topic 'Improving 'Research Interest' of your Research Publications'. More than 200 faculty members and research scholars benefitted from the webinar. On 4 June 2020, a webinar was organized for students on the topic 'Career Options in Post Covid Age: Challenges and Opportunities' by Mr Jatin Chawla, from Centre for Career Development. The webinar attracted the presence of more than 250 students.

IQAC organized a Workshop on 'Family Yoga for Health, Fitness and Immunity' on the occasion of World Yoga Day (21 June 2020) for students, faculty and non teaching staff.

10 days online **Add on Course on 'Legal Awareness'** was organized for students by MAC-IQAC and Internal Complaints Committee in association with Delhi State Legal Authority to spread Legal Literacy amongst the younger generation, to spread awareness about important Laws/Statute enacted in India and also to spread aware about DLSA. The course conducted from 18 October 2020 to 10 November 2020 addressed important issues such as "Equal Access to Justice"- Social Justice and Constitution of India, Understanding Indian Criminal Justice System, Overview of Cyber Laws, Equality in Practice - Laws in force for Protection of Women, Functioning of Police Administration & Virtual Tour of Police Station, Contractual Liabilities & Rent Laws: Jurisprudence and Applications, 'Rights of Children' & 'Wrongs by Children' – Important legal Provisions, Work with Dignity-Insights of The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 201, A Discussion on Purpose & Provisions of Right to Information Act, "Equal Access to Justice"- Role n Duties of DSLSA, Virtual Tour of DSLSA/DLSA Virtual Tour of District Court. An online test was conducted at the end of the course. A total of 134 students benefitted from the add on course.

MAC- IQAC and Internal Complaints Committee in association with East District Legal Services Authority organized an **online awareness programme on the topic "Sexual Harassment at Workplace"** on 10 February 2021. Ms Sonal Chauhan, Legal Aid Counsel, from East District Legal Services Authority explained in detail about various laws pertaining to Sexual harassment at work place to the audience which comprised of students, teaching faculty and non teaching staff.
